

HUNTLEY CURLING CLUB 2021-22

PRESIDENT'S CHALLENGE INFORMATION SHEET (FAQ's)

1) WHAT IS THE PRESIDENT'S CHALLENGE?

The President's Challenge is an annual competition between Huntley, Richmond, Almonte and Arnprior curling clubs, for bragging rights about the best overall quality of curlers in each club. Each club will field teams in each of seven (7) divisions:

- Senior Mixed – 2 Teams of two men and two women aged 60 plus (as of Jan. 1, 2022)
- Senior Women – 1 Team of four women aged 60 plus (as of Jan. 1, 2022)
- Senior Men – 1 Team of four men aged 60 plus (as of Jan. 1, 2022)
- Open Mixed – 2 Teams of two men and two women aged 19 plus (as of Jan. 1, 2022)
- Open Women – 2 Teams of four women aged 19 plus (as of Jan. 1, 2022)
- Open Men – 2 Teams of four men aged 19 plus (as of Jan. 1, 2022)
- Colts (U6) – 2 Teams – composed of any gender combination – with less than 6 years curling experience as of Sept 2021 – aged 19 plus (as of Jan. 1, 2022)

2) WHEN IS THE EVENT HELD?

The event will take place March 11-12-13, 2022 at Huntley Curling Club.

3) HOW MANY MATCHES DOES EACH TEAM PLAY?

Each team will play three matches over the three day period.

4) HOW LONG IS EACH MATCH?

Each match will be 6 ends, with a time limit.

5) HOW WILL WINNERS BE DETERMINED?

Points will be awarded for wins, ties and losses, as well as final score and ends won. Total points from all matches will determine the club that wins the overall event and takes home the event trophy. There are also trophies for the winners in each division.

6) HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The cost is \$60 per curler. This includes 3 matches and 3 meals, for the event in March.

Note that for the Qualifying Playdown event at HCC on December 29-30, there is no cost to enter, until you reach the March event.

7) HOW DO I REGISTER TO PLAY FOR HUNTLEY?

8) WHAT HAPPENS IF MORE THAN THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF TEAMS SIGN UP TO PLAY IN ANY DIVISION?

We will accommodate all teams signing up for any division. If more than the required number of teams sign up to play in any given division, there will be a "Qualifying Playdown" to determine which teams will represent Huntley. These Playdowns take place December 29-30, 2021.

9) WHAT OTHER INFORMATION DO I NEED TO KNOW?

A curler may only register for one team in one division.

Spares are allowed but again, may only play for one team.

Stick curling is allowed in all events.

5 person teams are eligible, subject to the fact that a curler can play for only one team.

10) WHEN SHOULD I REGISTER?

Registration for this event has been set up on the HCC website.

Registration closes on December 19, 2021.
